### **2019-2020 Parent & Family Engagement 1% Budget Survey** **Summary**

All parents of students at Mt. Zion Elementary were presented with a Parent and Family Engagement 1% Budget input form and asked to provide feedback on how we should spend the Title I Parent and Family Engagement 1% Budget. The 1% Budget input forms were presented to parents at two different meetings on Monday, October 7, 2019 at 10 am and Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 4 pm. Input forms were sent home to all parents on September 30, 2019 in students' blue folders, input forms were posted on the school website at <http://clayton.116.schooldesk.net>, and placed on the counter in front office, flyers were posted on the doors and windows in the front lobby, forms were available in the Parent Resource Center and the meeting was advertised on the school marquee.

#### **Results from the survey were as follows:**

*A total of 129 parents completed the survey.*

- 108 parents were in favor of the way the budget. **(No comments or suggestions were submitted.)**
- 1 parents did not agree with budget. **(No comments or suggestions were submitted.)**
- 20 parents agreed with the proposed budget yet made suggestions such as funding field trip cost for parents who cannot afford them, spending more money on effective technological communication and continuing to provide free resource for parents.

#### **The majority of parents agreed that the Parent and Family Engagement 1% Budget should be spent as follows:**

- Provide supplemental materials in English and Spanish to support instruction at home.
- Activities to encourage parental engagement and volunteering at schools.
- Workshops focused on instruction and curriculum for parents to help their child at home with homework and math skills.
- Resources to support communication between home and school.

Based on the survey results, parents agreed that the Parent and Family Engagement 1% Budget will be utilized to continue to provide supplemental material to support instruction for at home learning or use, activities to encourage parental engagement, workshops focused on instruction and curriculum for parents to help students at home, and resources to support communication between home and school.

**Mt. Zion Elementary will spend the 2019-2020 Parent & Family Engagement 1% Budget (\$2,496) funds as follows:**

**\$1,493.00** - *Supplemental materials to support instruction at home for parent-student use. We will purchase additional books and Reading, ELA and Math resources for the Parent Resource Center Library and allow parents to check them out as needed.*

**\$395.00** - *Activities to encourage parental engagement at school. We will purchase new parental involvement materials from our educational resource partners such as Parent Institute and Channing Bee.*

**\$608.00** - *Workshops to support instruction and curriculum for students. We will purchase new workshop material to utilize for workshops conducted by the Parent Liaison. These will come from various vendors.*

We will combine the following in one of the other categories as per the suggestion of the Parent Liaison and Principal. Funding will most likely go to supplies for printing and distribution of parent resource activities.

**\$200.00** - *Resources to support communication between school and home.*

**\$100.00** - *Other: Office supplies for parents to use in the Parent Resource Center.*
